Stay Awake!

Aware that a new season of Advent is opening, I take time to pause before these readings and prepare to welcome prayerfully the new liturgical year.

The **First Reading** from the prophet Jeremiah (33:14-16) strikes a note of hope and confidence. The Lord is going to fulfil his promise to his people —the Messiah will come from the house of David.

Psalm 24 underlines the path we should follow as we wait for the coming of the Lord—he will teach and guide us in his ways of faithfulness and love.

The **Second Reading** (Thessalonians 3: 12-4) speaks of the Lord's second coming with all his saints. St. Paul exhorts us to live in the present according to the life and teaching of Jesus Christ.

The **Gospel** (Luke21: 25-28, 34-36) tells us to be ready for this second coming, Christ's coming in glory. The cosmic upheaval may sound terrifying but the followers of Christ, wide-awake and praying, can stand upright, confident that the Lord will come.

Collect: Grant your faithful, we pray almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at his coming, so that, gathered at his right hand, they may be worthy to possess the heavenly kingdom.
