St Mary's Parish choir: We are recommencing choir practice on Monday evenings at 8 pm in the church from 15th November. We are also welcoming new members to join us as we prepare to sing at Mass during Advent and for the Christmas vigil Mass.”

Confirmation 2021 - 2022: There will be a meeting for all young people of our Parish with their parents / guardians who wish to be Confirmed and are in Year 10 and above. This will take place on Monday 6th December at 8pm in the Parish Hall. There will be an enrolment Mass on Saturday 11th December at 6.30pm. Application forms are available in the porch of the Church. We look forward to seeing you all.
