The first reading from Isaiah on this 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B speaks about the servant who listens to God and does not turn away. This shows us the importance of being attentive to God's voice in our lives. We are called to be open and willing to hear what God has to say to us. Listening to God means being present and paying attention. It involves setting aside time for prayer and reflection. By doing this, we can better understand God's will for us and how we should live. In our busy lives, it can be hard to find quiet moments. But making time to listen to God can bring peace and direction

In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus asks His disciples who they think He is. Peter responds, "You are the Christ." This moment is a turning point in the Gospel of Mark, leading towards Jesus' suffering and death in Jerusalem. Like Peter, we are called to declare our faith in Jesus and then follow him, even when it is difficult. Indeed, Jesus calls us to renounce ourselves, take up our cross and follow Him. We pray today that we may listen to His voice and follow His path, knowing that, even when it is difficult, this path is the only one that leads to true life.

### HOME MISSION SUNDAY (EVANGELII SUNDAY)

Today, we celebrate Home Mission Sunday or Evangelii Gaudium Sunday in our parishes. It gives us the opportunity to reflect on the great mandate we have been given by the Risen Lord to evangelize the whole world. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations," the Lord commissions us, as we hear in Matthew 28:19.

A second collection will also be taken today to support the work of the Bishops' Conference Mission Directorate. Please hold this important work in your prayers.

## POPE FRANCIS WED. AUDIENCE ON VIRTUES AND VICES 9

Dear brothers and sisters: In our catechesis on the virtues and the vices, we now turn to envy and vainglory. Envy, already present in the story of Cain and Abel, is a destructive force fuelled by resentment towards others, and can lead to deadly hatred. The remedy to envy lies in Saint Paul's exhortation: "Love one another with brotherly affection, compete in esteeming one another" (*Rom 12:10*). Vainglory is marked by an inflated self-esteem, a craving for constant praise and frequently prone to using other people for one's own ends. Saint Paul's example of boasting of his weakness rather than achievements offers an effective way for overcoming vainglory. May we, like him, know that God's grace is sufficient, since his power is made perfect in weakness, and all the more gladly boast of our weaknesses, that the power of Christ may set us free for a more generous love of others.
