Sunday 3rd, 10th & 17th August 2025 – Pages 117, 121 & 124

The 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C reminds us not to place our trust in wealth or things. Money, comfort, and success can disappear quickly. We may work hard, but if we only chase what we can see or own, we miss what truly matters. Life is short, and we do not know when it will end. The readings today invite us to focus on God instead of storing up treasures on earth. God wants us to be rich in love, mercy, and faith. These are the things that last. When we live with this in mind, we find peace and purpose.

The 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C instructs us to live each day with trust in God. We do not know when Jesus will return, so we are called to stay ready. This means living with care, doing what is right, and keeping our faith strong. This Sunday also helps us think about how we use the gifts God has given us. We are stewards. We are meant to serve, not just wait. The readings today teach us that faith is active. We show our love for God by how we live each day.

The 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C tells us that following Jesus is not always easy. His message brings truth, but not everyone wants to hear it. Some will push back. Even families may feel tension when one person chooses to follow Christ fully. Faith can cause division, but Jesus calls us to stay strong and keep going. This Sunday helps us see that real faith takes courage. We may face hard moments, but we are not alone. Jesus knows what it's like to be rejected. So we are asked to stay faithful, even when it's tough.

The Feasts of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is on Friday 15th August and is a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics. Masses will be at 9.15am and 7.30pm that day.

Fr Mark will be away from Sunday 3rd August until Monday 18th August, but leaves the parish in the more than capable hands of Fr Jude.

THE RELICS OF ST ANDREW, ST MARGARET OF SCOTLAND AND ST COLUMBA

will be brought by the Knights of St Columba to Brentwood Cathedral on 5th Aug, transferred to St Mary, Mother of God on the morning of 6th Aug and then, on the morning of 7th Aug to Our Lady of Compassion, West Ham. From there, they will travel to St Alban's, Elm Park on the morning of 8th Aug and then on 9th Aug leave for Chingford, their last stop in this diocese. Provisional times for veneration are shown on the poster in the Church Porch but may be altered if necessary.

We will then be in contact with you directly once programme details become available. We can tell you, though, that the course will begin in September, but this is subject to finding a sufficient number of adult/ parent helpers to run the course, so please contact the parish office if you are able to help. The minimum expectations for the course are attendance at the sessions and attendance at weekly Mass on Sunday or Saturday night.

RCIA / JOURNEY IN FAITH PROGRAMME: We begin a new Journey of Faith programme on Thursday 11th September 2025 at 7.00pm in Parish Hall. It is designed for adults, falling into 3 categories i) for those who are not Catholics but who are interested in becoming one *or* just want to find out a bit more, ii) for those who are Catholics but who have not yet been Confirmed, and iii) for Catholics who would like to revisit their faith from the ground-up. Please let the Parish Office know if you are interested stating which category you fall into - just email us.

CONFIRMATION 2025/26: If your child is in Year 9 or above (from September) and they would like to make their Confirmation in 2026, please email the parish office to register your interest as soon as possible. Applications after Sunday 14th September will not be accepted. A meeting for parents and young people will take place on Tuesday 16th September 2025 at 7.30pm in the Church and the course will formally begin with a Welcome Session and Mass on Saturday 27th September. When registering your interest, please include your child's full name, a contact number and a picture of their Baptism & First Holy Communion certificates. The minimum expectations for the course are attendance at the Confirmation sessions and attendance at weekly Mass on Sunday or Saturday night.
