## **21st SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME** Sunday 24th August 2025 – Page 127

On the 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C, we hear in the first reading from Isaiah how God gathers people from all corners of the earth. The message is clear. God's love is not limited to one group. He wants all people to be saved. Having said that, this Sunday reminds us that following God is not always easy. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks about the narrow door. He says that many will try to enter, but not all will succeed. We must do our best, then, to follow Christ and his teaching. This takes effort, trust, and a steady heart. The Letter to the Hebrews tells us that discipline is part of love. Just as a parent disciplines their child, God disciplines us. This discipline, of course, is aimed at helping us to grow stronger: 'for the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained in it.'

This Sunday invites us to keep walking with God, even when the road is hard. God is calling all people to come and share in His joy. Let us respond with open hearts and ready hands.

MASS INTENTIONS FOR 2026: Due to the high demand for Mass intentions at St Mary's, we have reviewed our current system to ensure it remains fair and accessible to everyone.

Starting from 1st September, the 2026 Mass intention diary will open only for the months of January to April.

Please note the following important changes:

- For the period of January to April 2026, a maximum of 5 Masses can be booked per person/family- additional Mass Intentions can be sent by us to other parishes in need.
- Intentions for Sunday Masses will be limited to one per person/family every three months, to allow more people the opportunity to request Sunday Mass intentions.
- The suggested offering for a Mass intention is £10, in line with the updated guidance from the Diocese, but clearly, for those with limited means, no specific amount will be demanded, and for those struggling financially, no payment will be expected. Please note that the financial offering for Mass (also known as the Mass stipend) is not the cost of the Holy Mass itself, which is priceless, but is a way of supporting the financial needs of the priest, so, it should never be thought of as a payment for Mass.

We thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we implement these changes to better serve our parish community.

### POPE LEO'S WED. AUDIENCE ON 'JESUS OUR HOPE' JUBILEE 2025. 10.

Dear Brothers and Sisters, in our continuing catechesis on the Jubilee theme of "Jesus Christ our Hope", we now consider Jesus' miraculous cure of the paralytic at the pool of Bethesda. Many physically disabled people came to bathe there in hope of a cure, yet Jesus chose that man, who had been paralyzed for thirty-eight years and was unable to enter the pool by himself. Jesus' question to him – "Do you want to be healed?" – was penetrating. It challenged the paralytic's sense of helplessness and resignation, and invited him to hope that his life could be changed. Jesus tells him to stand, take up his mat and walk. The mat was in fact the symbol of the man's past paralysis, physical and spiritual, which he can now accept and leave behind as he begins his new life. In this Jubilee of hope, may we remember in our prayers all those who suffer and feel tempted to discouragement. Whatever problems or setbacks we may face in life, let us turn to Jesus, acknowledge our desire for healing, and accept his promise of freedom and newness of life.

On Thursday evenings, during our rosary, the book will be placed before the statue of Our Lady, where we will pray, asking for Her intercession for your intentions and the needs of our parish. CHILDREN IN YEAR 5 FROM SEPTEMBER: The parents of Year 5 children who are applying for Secondary Schools next year (October 2026) are invited to enrol for the Year 5 Mass attendance register which will begin the weekend of 18<sup>th</sup>/19<sup>th</sup> October. The register facilitates a fair approach to the signing of Certificates of Practice which confirm that a family is coming to Mass each Sunday/or Saturday night in accordance with the teaching of the Catholic Church. For the purposes of the enrolment this year, we ask you to email us the following details – child's name, parents names, contact number, photo of Baptism & First Holy Communion certificates no later than Monday 13<sup>th</sup> October. For the sake of transparency, the register itself will be strictly applied. More information will be supplied once families have enrolled.

RCIA / JOURNEY IN FAITH PROGRAMME: We begin a new Journey of Faith programme on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 at 7.00pm in Parish Hall. It is designed for adults, falling into 3 categories i) for those who are not Catholics but who are interested in becoming one *or* just want to find out a bit more, ii) for those who are Catholics but who have not yet been Confirmed, and iii) for Catholics who would like to revisit their faith from the ground-up. FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2025/26: If your child is going into Year 3 or above in September and they would like to make their First Holy Communion in 2026, please email the Parish Office to register your interest as soon as possible. *Applications after Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September will not be accepted.* Please include your child's full name, a contact number and a picture of their Baptism certificate. We will then be in contact with you directly once programme details become available. We can tell you, though, that the course will begin in September, but this is subject to finding a sufficient number of adult/ parent helpers to run the course, so please contact the parish office if you are able to help. The minimum expectations for the course are attendance at the sessions and attendance at weekly Mass on Sunday or Saturday night.

CONFIRMATION 2025/26: If your child is in Year 9 or above (from September) and they would like to make their Confirmation in 2026, please email the parish office to register your interest as soon as possible. *Applications after Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> September will not be accepted.* A meeting for parents and young people will take place on Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2025 at 7.30pm in the Church and the course will formally begin with a Welcome Session and Mass on Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> September. When registering your interest, please include your child's full name, a contact number and a picture of their Baptism & First Holy Communion certificates. The minimum expectations for the course are attendance at the Confirmation sessions and attendance at weekly Mass on Sunday or Saturday night.
