The first reading for the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C reminds us of God's deep concern for the poor and His condemnation of dishonesty and greed. It highlights how some people exploit others for personal gain, showing disregard for justice and fairness. God sees these actions and warns of consequences for those who harm the vulnerable.

This reading challenges us to reflect on our own attitudes and actions. Do we treat others fairly? Are we attentive to the needs of the poor and those who cannot defend themselves? God calls us to a higher standard, one rooted in justice and love.

Caring for the poor is not just a good deed; it reflects God's own care for humanity. As disciples, we are called to reflect His goodness by helping those in need. Whether through small acts of kindness or larger efforts to support the vulnerable, we can show the world that God's justice and mercy are real.

## **EVANGELI GAUDIUM DAY:** A Call to Mission in England and Wales

In 2013, the first year of his pontificate, the late Pope Francis released an Apostolic Exhortation on the joy of the Gospel titled Evangelii Gaudium. In it, he encouraged the Christian faithful to "embark on a new chapter of evangelisation" marked by this joy, whilst striving to find new paths to proclaim the Gospel in today's world. He wrote:

We cannot forget that evangelisation is first and foremost about preaching the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ or who have always rejected him. Many of these are quietly seeking God, led by a yearning to see his face... Christians have the duty to proclaim the Gospel without excluding anyone. Evangelii Gaudium, §14

This is the challenge and opportunity we take up on Evangelii Gaudium Sunday. Formerly known as Home Mission Sunday, Evangelii Gaudium Sunday is celebrated each year on the Third Sunday of September.

The work of encounter and evangelisation is promoted through the Directorate for Mission. Through this directorate, the vision of the Holy Father is embraced in a fuller way and promotes the whole ideal of proclamation, evangelisation, dialogue and catechesis.

A second collection will also be taken to support the work of the Bishops' Conference Mission Directorate. Please hold this important work in your prayers.



#### POPE LEO'S WED. AUDIENCE ON 'JESUS OUR HOPE' JUBILEE 2025.

Dear brothers and sisters, in our catechesis on the Jubilee theme of "Christ our Hope," we continue our reflection on Jesus' passion, death and resurrection by considering Jesus' revelation at the Last Supper that one of his disciples will betray him. Despite the seeming harshness, Jesus' words are not meant to condemn or humiliate his betrayer. They are rather the truth spoken with profound love, compassion and sorrow. When we reflect honestly on our own life, the question of the Apostles becomes our own: "Is it me?" Asking this question opens a space for truth in our hearts. This is important since openness to salvation begins with the awareness that we can break trust with the Lord through our sins. Despite our faults, our hope consists nevertheless in the fact that even if we fail him, he will never fail us; if we betray him, he will never betray us. Let us allow ourselves, then, to be touched by his forgiving love, so that we may truly be reborn as his beloved children.
