OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Sunday 23rd November 2025 – Page 167

The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, formerly referred to as "Christ the King," was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living, and organizes his life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's kingship over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations.

The institution of the feast of the Kingship of Christ, then, was intended to be a rallying-call to all Christians to acknowledge the sovereignty of Christ, not only over all Christians and all men but over all of creation. He is king of all creation because, as the second reading today says, "through him, by him and in him all things subsist." Therefore, he is the sovereign Master, Ruler, Protector and Judge of all created things. The title of King was chosen to express all these prerogatives, because he himself, in his moment of deepest humiliation, admitted to Pilate that he was King. He is given this title in most of the Old Testament prophecies concerning him.

So, today let us renew our loyalty to Christ our King. We are privileged and proud to be his subjects. As members of his Church on earth we are as yet in the preparatory stage of that kingdom. If we do the little that he asks of us, during this period of preparation, we are assured of being full citizens in his eternal kingdom of happiness and peace.

KNOW YOUR FAITH CORNER

Understanding the Holy Mass

The Holy Mass is the highest act of Christian worship. It is both a meal and a sacrifice, rooted in the mystery of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. The Mass has two inseparable parts: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist, together forming one single act of worship.

- 1. **The Liturgy of the Word**: In this part, God speaks to His people through the Scriptures. We listen to His voice in the readings, psalm, and Gospel. The homily helps us to understand and apply the Word of God in our daily lives.
- 2. **The Liturgy of the Eucharist**: Here, the Word becomes flesh again among us. The bread and wine offered are transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ. The same sacrifice of Calvary is made present in a sacramental way; not repeated but re-presented.

So, each time we come to Mass, let us listen to the Word with open hearts and unite ourselves with Christ's sacrifice on the altar. The Lord who speaks to us in Scripture is the same Lord who gives Himself to us in the Eucharist. – **Fr Jude**
