

## **THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT - GAUDETE SUNDAY**

"Rejoice: the Lord is near." As Christmas draws near, the Church emphasizes the joy which should be in our hearts over all that the birth of our Saviour means for us. The great joy of Christians is to see the day drawing near when the Lord will come again in His glory to lead them into His kingdom. The oft-repeated Veni ("Come") of Advent is an echo not only of the prophets but also of the conclusion of the Apocalypse of St. John: "Come, Lord Jesus," the last words of the New Testament. Today is known as Gaudete Sunday. The term Gaudete refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon, "Rejoice". Rose vestments are worn to emphasize our joy that Christmas is near, and we also light the rose candle on our Advent wreath.

### **KNOW YOUR FAITH CORNER - Confession: The Power of God's Mercy.**

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is one of the most tender expressions of God's love for His people. In the confessional, we do not stand before a judge waiting for condemnation; we stand before a Father who longs to lift burdens, restore peace, and renew the heart. Confession is not about shame; it is about grace. It is where the weight we have carried, sometimes for years, finally meets the mercy of Christ who says, "*Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest.*" (*Matthew 11:28*) When we confess with sincerity, something profound happens: God heals what is wounded, strengthens what is weak, and rekindles what has grown cold. The sacrament gives us more than forgiveness. It gives us freedom. It gives us a fresh start. It gives us the courage to live again as children of the light. It gives us special grace to avoid sins and occasions of sin. It draws us closer to Jesus. Many people hesitate because they fear embarrassment or feel unworthy. But the Lord already knows our struggles; He waits not to condemn but to embrace. The priest is simply the instrument, Christ Himself is the one who absolves, comforts, and restores. So, our advent reconciliation service this year is another opportunity for us to tap from the fountain of Christ's mercy and graces. – Fr. Jude

**CONTACTLESS CARD DONATION TERMINAL:** We now have a self-service, contactless card donation terminal. You can use it to make Parish Donations, offertory and second collection contributions, and to pay for candles and repository items. The contactless card donation terminal also helps you to Gift Aid your donations. For those who are taxpayers, we want to appeal to you to consider to Gift Aid your donations, as this will help us claim extra 25% from HMRC at no extra cost for you. What this means is that, for every £1 you donate to the church, HMRC gives the church 25p extra. The contactless card donation terminal is located in the parish porch. Fr Jude will be available to help for those who will need assistance to navigate the contactless card donation terminal.
