Listen to his voice.

As we live through these dark winter days, we may be comforted by the words of the **psalmist** (Psalm 95), who encourages us to listen to the Lord's voice and not to grumble as the Israelites did at Massah and Meribah in the desert.

In the **First Reading** (Deuteronomy 18: 15–20), Moses announces a true prophet speaking God's words and commandments.

In the **Gospel** (Mark 1: 21–28), we meet this true prophet in the person of Jesus, who teaches the people with authority, making a deep impression on his audience. Even unclean spirits obey him.

In the **Second Reading** (1 Cor. 7: 32–35), Paul, believing that the end of the world is near, encourages the Corinthians to free them from all worry. Whatever their marital status, he urges them to focus their undivided attention on the Lord, showing their devotion to him.

This week I may want to pray for all those who find it difficult to listen to God's voice, especially if he chooses to speak through the people we meet. Perhaps I can also focus on keeping my full attention on the Lord, trusting that he will help me to avoid distractions from the one thing that matters: listening to him.

Sadly, Fr Ticão (actually Fr Antonio Luiz Marchioni) died on New Year's Day in Santa Marcelina Itaquera Hospital at the age of 68. For years he had been parish priest of the Parish of São Francisco de Assis, São Paulo and was known for his social work, mainly in the East zone of São Paulo. He was a great priest, one that Pope Francis would be proud of for his work with the poor.
